LaBarque Creek Watershed, Lum Miller Hollow – Glade Restoration**

Project Details

The work will include cutting down selected cedar trees, trimming lower limbs from other trees, construction of erosion check dams with the downed timber and limbs, scattering limb slash and making limb slash burn piles. Also, invasive plants and trees will be cut and painted. Despite the work descriptions, much of the work requires only light labor.

Directions to the Site

Note, all mileage is cumulative from I-44 and Hwy 109! Continue south on Hwy 109 past I-44 for 2.2 miles and turn left on Hwy W, at 7.5 miles turn right on Byrnesville Road, at 14.4 miles turn right on Sand Cut Road, then within 1/10 of a mile Don Robinson Road will be on the right. Don Robinson Road is not paved and there is not the conventional street sign; instead, there is a post set back from Sand Cut Road with the name 'Don Robinson'. Continue slowly on Don Robinson Road to the house, where volunteers will meet.
